THE BIRTH OF CHRISTMAS Matthew 1:22-23

²² Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: ²³ "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."

The VIRGIN BIRTH literally means that Mary was a virgin when she conceived, she delivered Jesus as a virgin, and all the way from the time of her conception to the time she gave birth to Jesus, she remained a virgin and never knew a man.

celebrating the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ. It is a short family service. Children are welcome. No childcare will be available. We will have activity packets available for your children at the door.


