## UNLEAVENED BREAD

Exodus 12:13-20



### Exodus 12:13-20

<sup>13</sup> 'The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

<sup>14</sup> 'Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance. <sup>15</sup> 'Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, but on the first day you shall remove leaven from your houses; for whoever eats anything leavened from the first day until the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel. <sup>16</sup> 'On the first day you shall have a holy assembly, and another holy assembly on the seventh day; no work at all shall be done on them, except what must be eaten by every person, that alone may be prepared by you. <sup>17</sup> 'You shall also observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this very day I brought your hosts out of the land of Egypt; therefore you shall observe this day throughout your generations as a permanent ordinance. <sup>18</sup> 'In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at evening, you shall eat unleavened bread, until the twenty-first day of the month at evening. <sup>19</sup> 'Seven days there shall be no leaven found in your houses; for whoever eats what is leavened, that person shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he is an alien or a native of the land. <sup>20</sup> 'You shall not eat anything leavened; in all your dwellings you shall eat unleavened bread. '''

THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD IS THE SECOND OF THE HOLIDAYS AND IT CELEBRATES GOD LEADING HIS PEOPLE OUT OF BONDAGE.

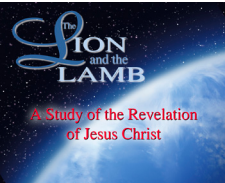
WEDNESDAY EVENING ACTIVITIES - 6:00 - 7:30 PM
