

## IT'S ALL ABOUT JESUS

### John 4:19-30

<sup>19</sup> The woman said to Him, “Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet.” <sup>20</sup> “Our fathers worshiped in this mountain, and you people say that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.” <sup>21</sup> Jesus said to her, “Woman, believe Me, an hour is coming when neither in this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father.” <sup>22</sup> “You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews.” <sup>23</sup> “But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers.” <sup>24</sup> “God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

<sup>25</sup> The woman said to Him, “I know that Messiah is coming (He who is called Christ); when that One comes, He will declare all things to us.” <sup>26</sup> Jesus said to her, “I who speak to you am He.”

<sup>27</sup> At this point His disciples came, and they were amazed that He had been speaking with a woman, yet no one said, “What do You seek?” or, “Why do You speak with her?” <sup>28</sup> So the woman left her waterpot, and went into the city and said to the men, <sup>29</sup> “Come, see a man who told me all the things that I have done; this is not the Christ, is it?” <sup>30</sup> They went out of the city, and were coming to Him.
