THE LORD'S SUPPER IN THREE TENSES

Luke 22:14-20



¹⁴ When the hour had come,
He reclined at the table, and the apostles
with Him. ¹⁵ And He said to them, "I have earnestly
desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer;
¹⁶ for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is
fulfilled in the kingdom of God." ¹⁷ And when He had
taken a cup and given thanks, He said, "Take this and
share it among yourselves; ¹⁸ for I say to you, I will
not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the
kingdom of God comes." ¹⁹ And when He had taken some
bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them,
saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this
in remembrance of Me." ²⁰ And in the same way He took
the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is
poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood."

I. THE LORD'S SUPPER _____

¹¹ 'Now you shall eat it in this manner: with your loins girded,
your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you
shall eat it in haste—it is the LORD'S Passover. ¹² 'For I will
go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down
all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and
against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments—I am the
LORD. ¹³ 'The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where
you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no
plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of
Egypt. ¹⁴ 'Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall
celebrate it as a feast to the LORD; throughout your generations
you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.

²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes. **1 Corinthians 11:26**

16 for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God.” **Luke 22:16**

1 Corinthians 11:23-29

²³ For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” ²⁵ In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.” ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes. ²⁷ Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. ²⁸ But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. ²⁹ For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly.
