LIVING BENEATH THE BLESSINGS OF GOD

FINDING GOD'S FAVOR

Malachi 3:7-18

⁷ “From the days of your fathers you have turned aside from My statutes and have not kept them. Return to Me, and I will return to you,” says the LORD of hosts. “But you say, ‘How shall we return?’”

⁸ “Will a man rob God? Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, ‘How have we robbed You?’ In tithes and offerings.” ⁹ “You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing Me, the whole nation of you!” ¹⁰ “Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, and test Me now in this,” says the LORD of hosts, “if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows.” ¹¹ “Then I will rebuke the devourer for you, so that it will not destroy the fruits of the ground; nor will your vine in the field cast its grapes,” says the LORD of hosts. ¹² “All the nations will call you blessed, for you shall be a delightful land,” says the LORD of hosts.

¹³ “Your words have been arrogant against Me,” says the LORD. “Yet you say, ‘What have we spoken against You?’” ¹⁴ “You have said, ‘It is vain to serve God; and what profit is it that we have kept His charge, and that we have walked in mourning before the LORD of hosts?’” ¹⁵ “So now we call the arrogant blessed; not only are the doers of wickedness built up but they also test God and escape.”

¹⁶ Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, and the LORD gave attention and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the LORD and who esteem His name. ¹⁷ “They will be Mine,” says the LORD of hosts, “on the day that I prepare My own possession, and I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him.” ¹⁸ So you will again distinguish between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him.

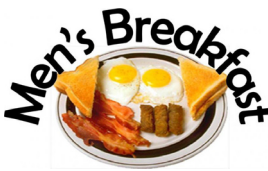
