

John 7:36-39

*33 Therefore Jesus said, "For a little while longer I am with you, then I go to Him who sent Me. 34 "You will seek Me, and will not find Me; and where I am, you cannot come." 35 The Jews then said to one another, "Where does this man intend to go that we will not find Him? 
### WEDNESDAY EVENING ACTIVITIES, 6:00-7:30 PM
